

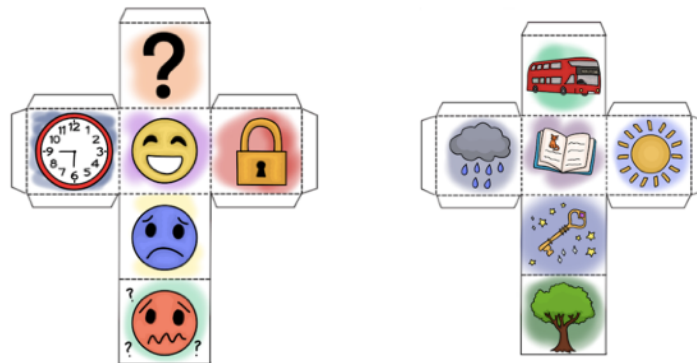
# Coliseum Cubes

*This activity is best suited for young people age 12 and under.*

Create your own exciting stories using our Coliseum Cubes. Working together with your family, lets see where your imagination takes you! You can even use our blank cube template to design you own cube. The possibilities are endless!

## How to make your Coliseum Cube

1. Print out the Coliseum Cubes and ask an adult to help you cut out the templates.
2. If you want, you can use the blank cube template to draw your own pictures. You could draw different characters, places, or objects. Use your imagination! (Make sure you finish your drawing before making your cubes.)
3. Fold along the lines on the template to create a cube shape.
4. Add glue to the flaps of the cube and stick them together. This can be tricky so ask an adult if you need help.



## How to play

1. Roll all of your Coliseum Cubes
2. Look at all of the pictures on the Cubes.
3. Use all of the pictures on the Cubes to tell a story- you can use the images in any order.
4. The next player will then roll the Coliseum Cubes and will continue the story.
5. You can keep playing until the story ends. Then you can start a new story.

## Top Tips

- There are no wrong answers
- Use your imagination
- Listen to all storytellers, try and add to the story you are telling together.
- Create your own Coliseum Cubes so you can tell more stories.
- You can play alone, in small groups, or big groups.
- After playing you could write down the favourite story you created so you don't forget it.
