

SNAP

This could be a view from the distance, a calming nature spot, a street that holds fond memories, a coffee shop in the town centre, the Coliseum... any-where. We want to see all of your favourite places.

Be sure to give your camera lens a wipe!

Take a SNAP of something beautiful

Use your phones HDR picture mode for evenly lit scenes and the most detail possible.

Taking a picture of person? Activate portrait mode.*


Activate your camera's gridlines and use them to aid your composition.

Place the most important element of your image along these lines.

This compositional approach is known as the rule of thirds.

Eg Take a landscape photo and position the horizon on either top or bottom horizontal line. The main subject of your image can be then positioned along a vertical line

*Please make sure you have permission to take photos of people. We will not be sharing images of people our gallery.

Take a SNAP where the old meets the new

Look up - can you see an old building next to a new one? Look down - can you see old and new life on the ground amongst the plants and flowers?

Look up! Take a SNAP of the clouds, the trees, the sky

Many photos are taken at chest height. Can you change your perspective? Adjust the angle of your composition. Can you get under or above your sub-ject?

Try pressing your screen with your finger dragging it up and down. This will allow you to control the 'exposure' or overall brightness/darkness of your photograph.

Try it without macro mode enabled and get in really close to create blurry ab-stracts of your favourite plants and flowers.
